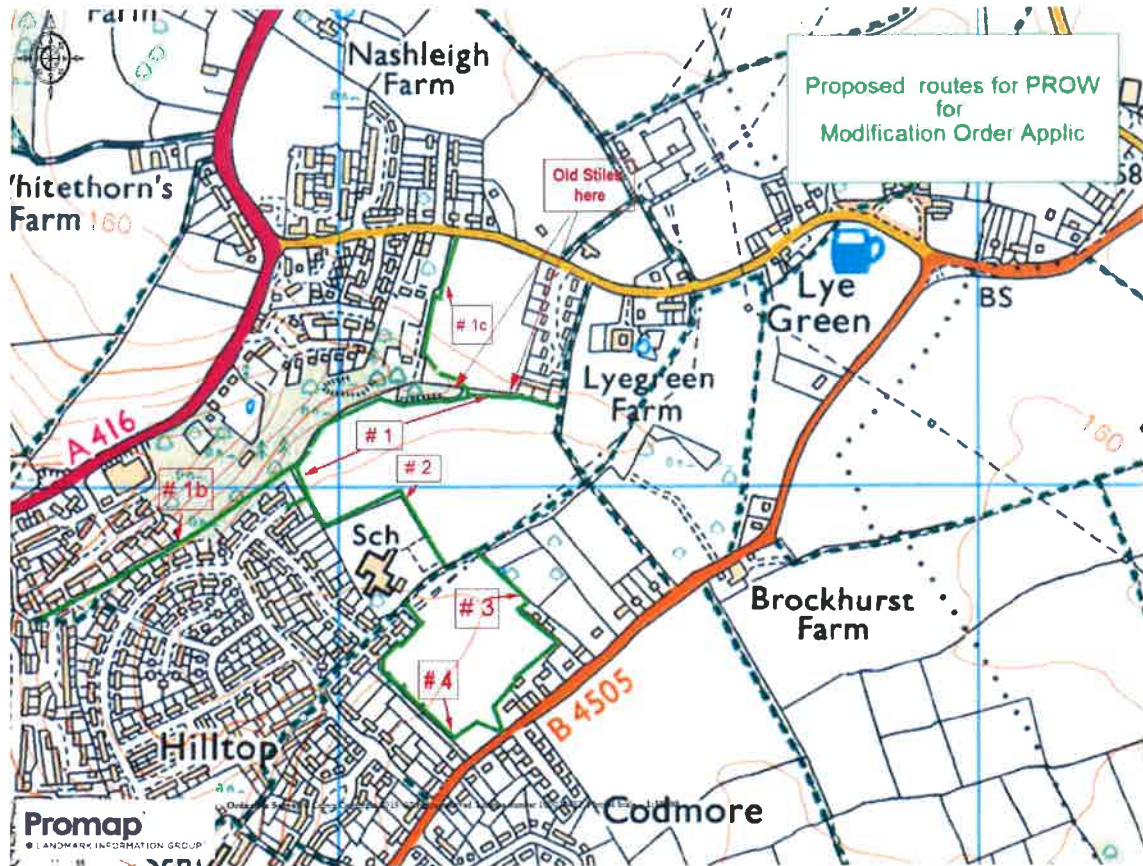

Route 1	497350 203134	Leaves PROW south of Deer Park Walk (35) heading west on well-established path (as shown on historic maps – south of 3)) following edge of wood (4) that veers SE (at 5) turning right (West) (just before 6) using a well-established path between residences into Hillcroft Road	496953 202980
Route 1b	497350 203134	As per Route 1 initially heading west (from 35) on well-established path (as shown on historic maps – south of 3) following edge of wood (4) but turning right into Nalder's Wood in corner of field (5), following another well-established track in woods to finish at PROW near Cobblers Court/Birch Way	496580 202821

Route 1c	497350 203134	As per Route 1 initially heading west (from 35) on well-established path (as shown on historic maps) but just before edge of wood (near point 3 - old stile) turn right (north) and then follow edge of northern field (past 2) until reaching field gate (1) at NW edge of field accessing Lycrome Road	497190 203387
Route 2	496953 202980	Leaving Hillcroft Road via well-established path between residences into fields turn right (SE) following field boundary on right until reaching boundary with Brushwood School, (6) then heading NE but following boundary (through 7) around school (SE) to intersect with PROW (at 8) on SE side of Brushwood School	497163 202876
Route 3	497222 202897	From point on PROW (17) within fields (as per Start Grid Ref) head SE following edge of wood on left, (16) turning right (SW at 15) following rear garden fences on left, turning left at private garden fences, (14) following boundary until reaching field gate with Lye Green Road. NOTE Route 3 also interacts with Route 4 to create a circular route. (by crossing field from 14 across to far western boundary)	497224 202589
Route 4	497224 202589	<u>From</u> Point on Lye Green Road by field gate, (near 13) enter field, veer left for circa 50m then follow track turning left to reach (W) boundary of field, then turning right (NW) following boundary on left (through points 11 & 10) including briefly turning right following boundary fence until re-joining PROW by Brushwood School. I acknowledge receipt of your application to modify the Definitive Map and Statement by adding public footpaths, Parish of Chesham.

The application has been given reference 16855CCU. I confirm your application is compliant with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 14 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The application will be investigated and a report will be presented to the County Council's Rights of Way Committee for an initial decision. Should the Committee accept the application, a Definitive Map Modification Order would be made and would be open to objection. If any objections are received in the requisite time period, the matter would then have to be referred to the Secretary of State for determination. If no objections were received, the route would then be confirmed.

Should the Committee reject the application, you would have a right of appeal to the Secretary of State.

At present, I am unable to say when the matter will be brought to the Committee as there are a number of other applications ahead of this one. All applications are dealt with in line with our statement of priorities, please see the document included.

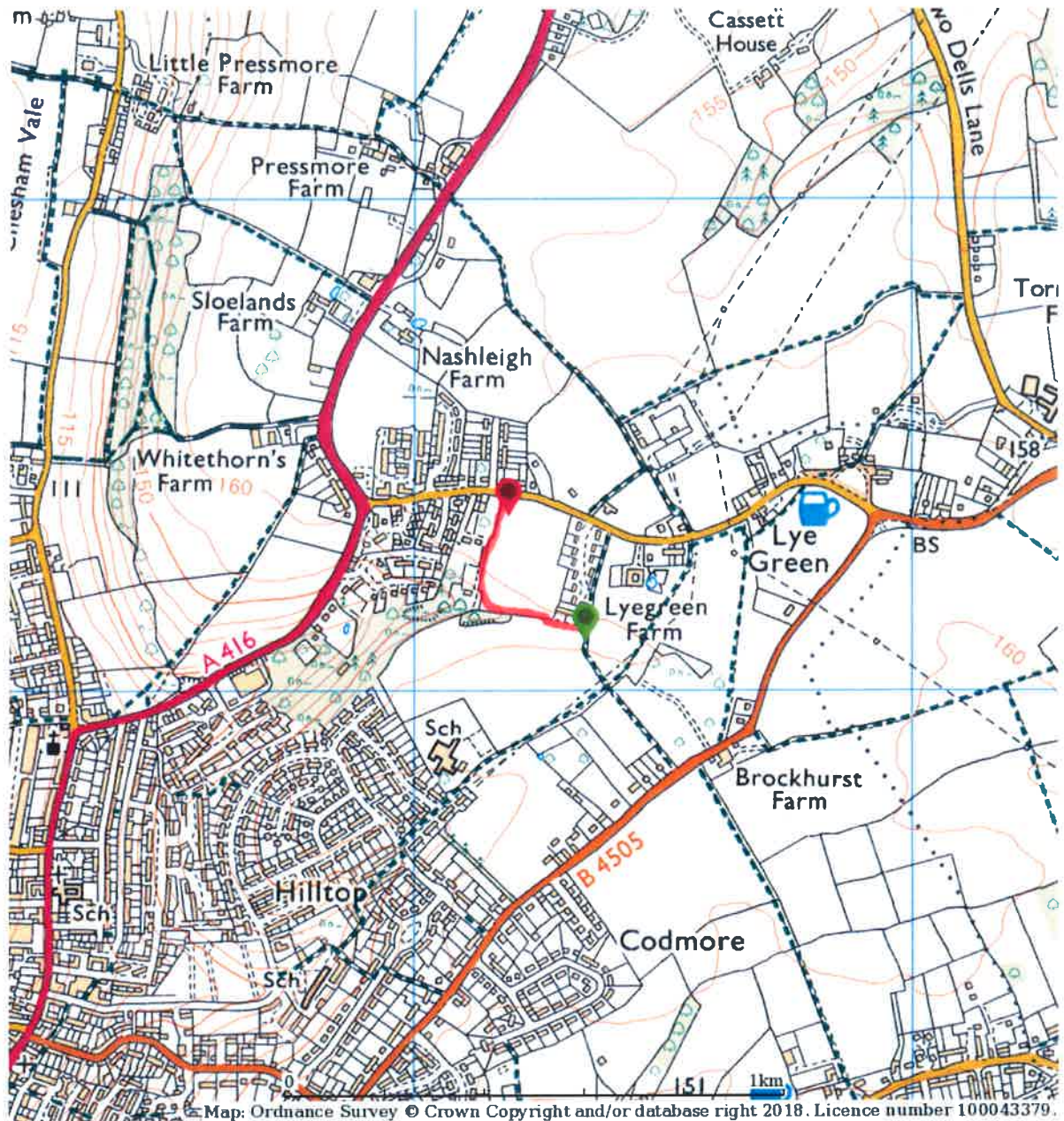

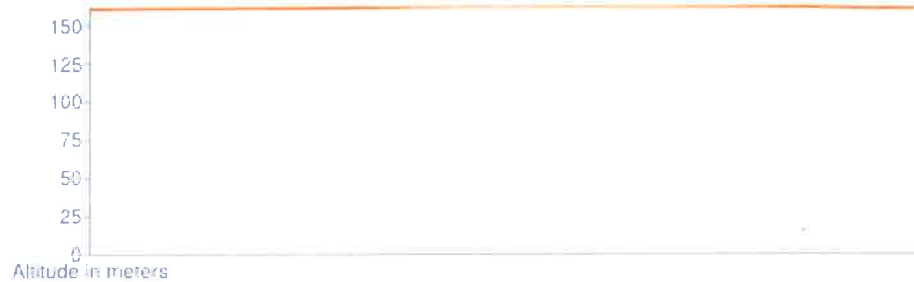

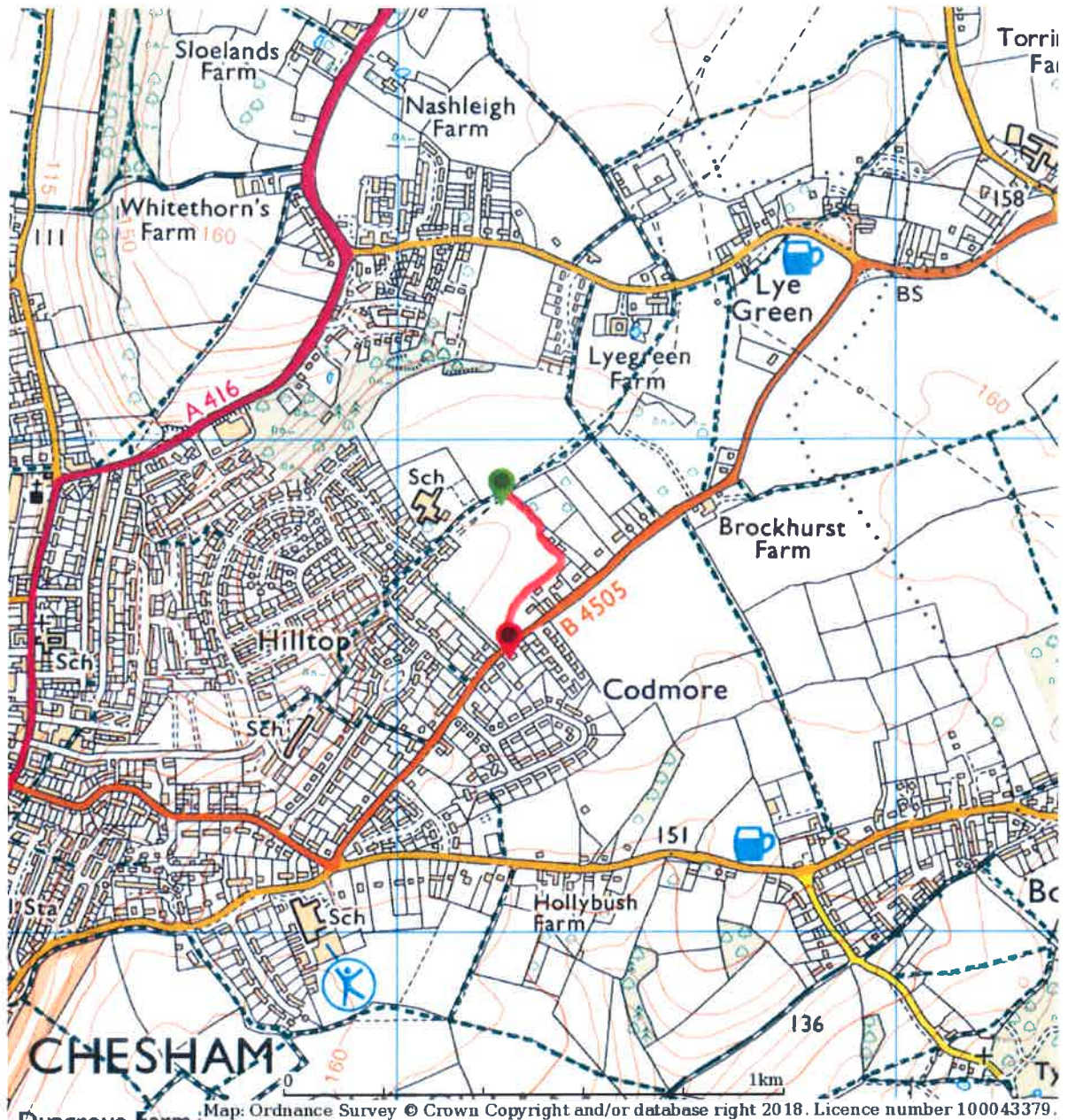

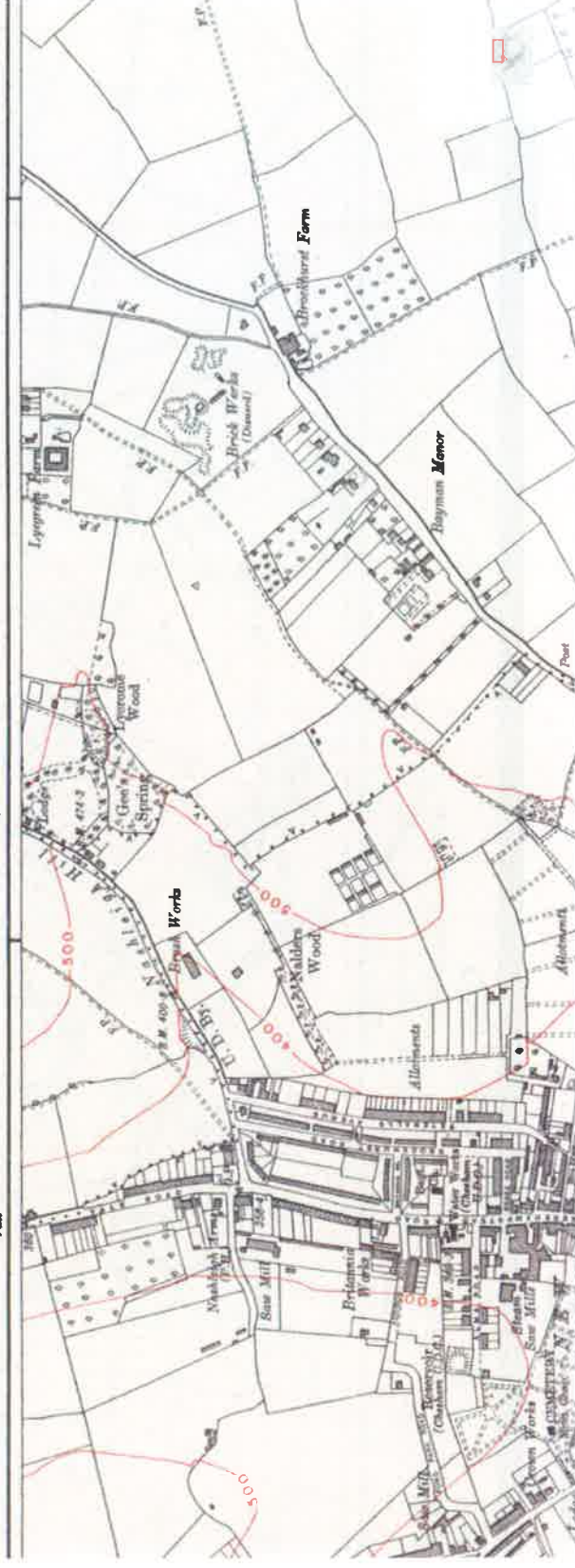
